## Mike's Select Paw Paw Seedlings



- These Seedlings are Grown from our Food Forest Paw Paw Trees which are all Grafted Cultivars\*
- Paw Paws come 80-100% True to Seed Meaning they have the Qualities of their Parents
- The 12+ Inch Tree Pots Assure Full Tap Root Health
- 2 Seedlings are Needed for Cross-Pollination. Any 2 Will Do!
- Paw Paws are Best Planted when Very Young & With Full Tap Root
- 12-15 Foot Recommended Spacing. 30 Foot Max for Pollination
- Top Growth is Slow for the First couple Years as the Tap Root Develops
- Planting in Full Sun is Ideal for Max Fruit Production but will Grow in Semi-Shade to Full Shade
- Protect Young Seedlings Planted in Full Sun for First couple Years with Shade Structure – Or just Tons of Mulch.
- Mulch!! Ideally a 6+ Foot Diameter Around Each Tree 6+ Inches Deep

\*Our seedling parents are a mix of Neal Peterson's collection (Shannandoah, Alleghany, Susquehanna, etc), and select others (Mango, Sunflower, Davis, PA Golden, etc).

At this point we do not offer grafted trees.
